ABOUT THE GRANT

The IMU-CDC Volunteer Lecturer Program is designed to foster research and international cooperation between mathematicians in developing countries and the international mathematical community by providing financial assistance to universities in developing countries to host a volunteer lecturer for 3-4 weeks as part of an intensive course.

Up to 4,400 EUR can be awarded to cover the expenses of the Volunteer Lecturer accumulated during their stay. This includes travel and living expenses, and costs relating to course preparations, such as prints and literature.* **

**Please note that the grant is not intended for the salary of the lecturer and cannot be used for hiring of an assistant.*

***Due to the COVID pandemic, the grant can also be used to support lectures conducted fully or partially online.*
